2025 - 2026 APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDING

The purpose of the grant program at Joliet Township Government is to provide financial support to Community and Non-Profit Agencies that actively contribute to the fulfillment of Joliet Township's mission and services. This grant initiative aims to foster positive and sustainable change within the community by investing in programs that align with the Township's core values and strategic objectives. Please read the COMMUNITY & NON-PROFIT GRANT PROTOCOL and provide the acknowledgment page signed in your submission.

The Joliet Township Supervisor will begin reviewing funding requests from non-profit community organizations within the month after submission. Applications that have passed initial review will be presented in the subsequent regularly scheduled board meeting. Applications that have not passed initial review will be contacted with up to three attempts to discuss the application.

If the second review meeting is rescheduled for a special meeting other than the regular board meeting, applicants will be notified of the new meeting date.

Due to the limited availability of funds, an organization that meets eligibility requirements shall only apply once per fiscal year. The Township board reserves the right to limit the amount of grant money available to any individual organization. The fiscal year begins April 1st and concludes March 31st. It is the applicant's duty to determine the timing appropriate to your grant request.

NOTE: Notwithstanding past experience, there is no guarantee that future requests will be approved. Former recipients will be asked for an accounting of past grants that include, but are not limited to, receipts, photos, and sign-in sheets. An incomplete application will be considered unqualified for funding. Be sure to specify the payee on the form, both name and address, and please understand that these checks are issued to organizations, not individuals. If you need additional space, use a separate page, and you are encouraged to attach supplementary information. Additional information may be requested upon review of your application, but please provide detailed responses to the questions in the application. You are strongly encouraged to have a representative present at the meeting to answer any questions.
